Recording a property inspection with a Garmin watch

Step 1 — Record and save your walk on the watch

- 1 **Open the activity menu:** Press the GPS / Start–Stop button (usually the top-right button).
- 2 **Select Walk:** Scroll through the list and select **Walk** (or **Navigate / Track Me** if you just want path data).
- 3 **Wait for GPS:** Stand still outdoors until the GPS signal indicator turns green.
- 4 **Start recording:** Press **Start** again to begin tracking your path as you inspect the property.
- 5 **Stop recording:** When you finish walking the property, press **Stop**.
- 6 **Save the activity:** Scroll down on the watch screen and select **Save**.

Step 2 — Sync the walk to Garmin Connect

First, get the walk off your watch and into your Garmin account. Pick whichever method fits what you have on hand:

- **Wireless (easiest):** Install the free **Garmin Connect** mobile app from the App Store or Google Play. Sign in with your Garmin account, turn on Bluetooth, and open the app with your watch nearby. It will sync automatically the first time you pair it and every time you open the app after a walk.
- **Wired (from a computer):** Plug your watch into your computer with its USB cable and open the free **Garmin Express** desktop app. Sign in and it will upload the walk to your Garmin account.

Once the walk shows up in your Garmin Connect account, move on to Step 3 to download the GPX file.

Step 3 — Download the GPX file

A **GPX file** is the little file that holds your walking path. You need to save it somewhere you can grab it — on your phone or computer — so you can upload it to Property Path. Pick whichever method matches the device you have in front of you.

Option A — From your phone (no computer needed)

Once your watch has synced to the Garmin Connect app, you can grab the GPX file straight from your phone's browser.

- 1 Close the Garmin Connect app and open your phone's web browser (Safari on iPhone, Chrome on Android).
- 2 Go to the Garmin Connect web portal (**connect.garmin.com**) and sign in with your Garmin account.
- 3 Tap **Activities** in the side menu, then **All Activities**.
- 4 Tap the walk you just recorded to open it.
- 5 Tap the **gear icon** in the top-right corner of the activity.
- 6 Tap **Export to GPX**. The file will save to your phone's Files app (iPhone) or Downloads folder (Android).
- 7 Come back to Property Path, tap **Upload walk**, pick the property, and select that GPX file.

Option B — From your computer

- 1 Open your browser and sign in to the Garmin Connect web portal (**connect.garmin.com**).
- 2 Click **Activities** in the left sidebar, then **All Activities**.
- 3 Click the walk you just recorded to open it.
- 4 Click the **gear icon** in the top-right corner.
- 5 Choose **Export to GPX**. The file will save to your Downloads folder.
- 6 Come back to Property Path, click **Upload walk**, pick the property, and choose that GPX file.

That's it — your inspection proof is ready to print or share.
